January 28, 2018, Petaling Jaya: A public forum was held at Persatuan SLE Malaysia's (PSLEM) Secretariat where Consultant Rheumatologist Dr Heselynn Hussein gave a talk on "Medications in SLE". This was followed by a second talk on "Managing Your Emotions" by Ms Shoba Aiyar, a registered Counsellor who is helping to train PSLEM's para-counsellors. 






February 24, 2018, Petaling Jaya: Dr Benjamin Cheah launched Persatuan SLE's Chinese New Year open house with the tossing of "yee sang" and shouts of blessings. This was followed with angpow distribution to the children by Professor Emeritus Datin Dr Norella Kong, one of the founding members of PSLEM. The event ended with a "Share & Care" session where patients and family members gathered to share their lupus life stories.

March 11, 2018, Sandakan, Sabah: PSLEM's Sabah Chapter also held its Chinese New Year open house. The highlight was a talk on "Kepentingan Bersenam untuk Pesakit SLE", followed by a Q&A session and a demonstration on light exercises. The day ended with a "Share & Care" session.



March 14 – 18, 2018, Kuala Lumpur: *Painting From The Heart* is the debut exhibition of Yeow Teck Chai, a self-taught watercolour artist and retired career civil servant. It showcases paintings that evoke memories of his simple *kampung* childhood in the seaside town of Kuantan to the mesmerising scenery and colours from his travels to various parts of the world.

Yeow is primarily self-taught, having had no formal art training apart from art classes in school. Born in the small town of Kuantan, his flair for drawing started during his early kampung years. As a mischievous youth, he once drew a five ringgit note and tried to use it as currency at a coffee shop! Later, he focused on the human physique with his monochrome sketches of runners and dancers, and portraits of his children.

A 14-year cancer survivor, he believes there is life after cancer: "I believe that my natural ability to paint is a gift from God. It is such a joy to share my passion with the community at large to benefit the less fortunate." All proceeds from the sale of paintings in the exhibition were donated to Persatuan SLE Malaysia and the Society for the Severely Mentally Handicapped. April 29, 2018, Kuala Lumpur: In conjunction with World Lupus Day (WLD), PSLEM brought SLE patients and their families together for a guided tour of the scenic KL Bird Park. This was followed by a talk entitled "A Future Without Fear" by Dr Valerie Jaques, who is also the association's Counseling Advisor.
